**GIRLS INC. SUMMER CAMP** is a fun filled 9 week camp. Members will participate in a variety of educational but fun activities such as: swimming, arts and crafts, cooking, science experiments, and computer lab...just to name a few. Girls will participate daily in age appropriate programming and activities. Girls are supervised by fun, experienced and trained staff members who all have participated in Girls Inc. programming. A daily schedule will be provided at registration. Below are some of our educational programs that will be offered this summer:

**GIRLS INCORPORATED SUMMER HOURS:** Regular hours are 6:45am-5:30pm, Monday through Friday. ***Doors will not be open prior to 6:45 AM.*** Summer dates are May 30 through July 28, 2017. We will be closed on July 4<sup>th</sup> in observance of Independence Day.

**REGISTRATION INFORMATION:** Registration for summer camp will begin **May 1<sup>st</sup>** from 9:00am-5:00pm. Any girl who will be entering kindergarten in the fall is eligible to be a Girls Incorporated member this summer. An adult or guardian must sign girls up for summer camp and special trips. The fee for Summer Camp is \$200 for members and \$225 for non-members if paid in full before May 26<sup>th</sup>. If paid after May 26<sup>th</sup>, the fee is \$225 for members and \$250 for non-members. Girls will receive a free Girls Inc. t-shirt upon paid registration. Daily rates are available for members at a rate of \$10 per day. The daily rate must be paid upon arrival each day. Activity fees include daily activities at the center and any offsite transportation. Additional fees may apply for special trips & afternoon swimming. Dues assistance is available for those who qualify. If you need help in paying fees please contact Ginger or Kelly at 522-2798 for more information. **MEMBERSHIP FOR GIRLS INC. TEENS (G.I.T.'S) ENTERING 7<sup>TH</sup> GRADE & UP:** This summer Girls Inc. is continuing our G.I.T. (Girls Inc. Teens) program. G.I.T. teens who will be entering 7<sup>th</sup> grade and up will assist younger members with activities throughout the day. G.I.T.'s might help a younger member get her sunscreen on before swimming, help her with a craft, help serve lunch, etc. Any girls interested in becoming a G.I.T. will need to attend training on Tuesday, May 23<sup>rd</sup> from 4:00-5:30pm. Girls in grades 7-9 will also receive educational programming. There is a \$25 supply fee for girls in grades 7-9. The fee offsets some of the G.I.T. program expense.

**SPECIAL ACTIVITIES** requiring sign up during registration include Offsite Excursions and Swim Lessons. Other weekly events requiring sign up include group swim and open gymnastics.

**OFFSITE EXCURSIONS:**

**FIREFLIES** (entering K & 1<sup>st</sup> grade) June 13 & July 10

**LADYBUGS** (entering grades 2 & 3) June 22 & July 20

**BUTTERFLIES** (entering grades 4, 5, & 6) June 14 & July 19

**GIT'S** (grade 7 and up) June 20 & July 21

Girls **must** be signed up to go on these trips. Because seating is limited we urge parents to sign their daughters up for these trips during registration in May. Detailed info on each trip is available during registration. **PARENTS:** We will need for you to pay for Offsite Excursions no later than 2 weeks before each trip. If payment is not received by the deadline girls' names will be removed from the list and replaced with girls from the waiting list. No phone call reminders will be made. There will be **no refund** for Offsite Excursions if you do not let us know **2 weeks** in advance that your daughter will not be going. Parents interested in going as chaperones should contact Girls Inc. at registration. There is no cost for chaperones except for their own lunch. Girls need to wear their Girls Inc. t-shirt on Offsite Excursions.

**SWIMMING** – Each week every group will have an opportunity to attend Seymour City Pool from 1:30-3:30. Girls must be signed up no later than noon on their swim day and bring \$1.00 with them when they sign up!

**SWIM LESSONS:** will be held at the Seymour City Pool in Shields Park. There is a \$25.00 fee for the lessons. Girls Incorporated will provide transportation from Girls Inc. to the pool and back. Swim lessons will be Monday thru Thursday starting June 19 and ending July 6. No lessons July 4<sup>th</sup> (Closed).

**FREE BREAKFAST & LUNCH:** This summer Girls Inc. has been invited by Seymour Community Schools to participate in their free summer breakfast & lunch through the USDA summer food service program. We will be walking to Seymour Middle School for breakfast & lunch. Girls should dress appropriately (rain jacket, umbrella if needed). Girls are welcome to bring their own breakfast & lunch, however, no cooking or heating options will be available.

**CONCESSIONS:** Concessions are available for purchase during snack times.

**PERSONAL ITEMS:**

Girls should not bring valuables with them to Girls Inc. We have no place to safely store them. Girls are encouraged to keep their money at the control desk or concession stand for safekeeping. Girls Inc. is not responsible for lost or stolen items. If a girl brings a cell phone she will need to keep it in the program office. Girls Inc. has a phone members can use for emergencies. We strongly urge members not to bring cell phones. Parents can call their daughter anytime at 522-2798.

**PARKING:** Please park in the marked spaces provided in the parking lot. Parents must come into the building to pick up your daughter. **ABSOLUTELY NO PARKING OR WAITING ON THE CIRCULAR DRIVE!** A big **THANK YOU** to parents that respect this safety rule!
